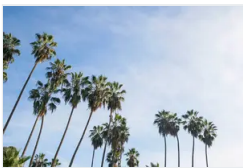

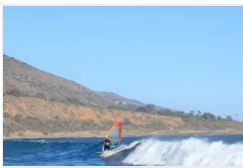
Day 1

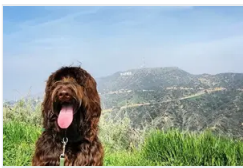

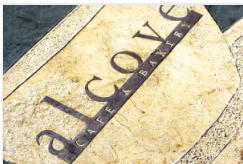

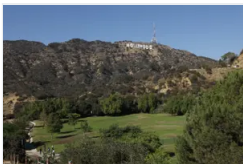

Playtime Under the Hollywood Sign



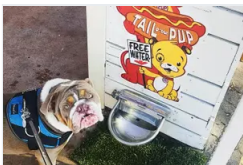
